COURSE OFFERINGS

CADET BAND (VPA)

COURSE ID: HS5105/HS5106

(WCS High School Course Description Guide)

Cadet band is available as an introductory band to train students for the technical and musical demands of the other performing bands. Students in this band will focus on the fundamentals of performance, such as developing a characteristic tone, rhythm and counting, music reading ability, interpretation skills, and overall musicality. Throughout the school year, various performance opportunities will be made available and/or required.

(SHHS Additional Information)

Cadet Band is primarily 9th grade band students. All 9th grade band students will take Cadet Band. Additionally, a few 10th graders each year are also in Cadet due to scheduling or other reasons. Cadet is also open to 11th and 12th grade band students who wish to take a second band class. Cadet Band is the place where our new students really begin to bond as a graduating class. With our students coming from primarily 2 middle schools, this aspect of band is very important.

CONCERT BAND (VPA)

COURSE ID: HS5101/HS5102

(WCS High School Course Description Guide)

This instrumental music ensemble performs a wide variety of genre and emphasizes the continued development of musical performance skills. Throughout the school year, various performance opportunities will be made available and/or are required.

(SHHS Additional Information)

Concert Band is primarily 10th grade band students. Additionally, some 11th and 12th grade band students are also in Concert Band due to scheduling or other reasons. Because the pacing is faster than Cadet Band and the musical literature is at a higher level, students must audition to be in this ensemble.

SYMPHONIC BAND (VPA)

COURSE ID: HS5111/HS5112

(WCS High School Course Description Guide)

This instrumental music ensemble performs an array of advanced instrumental music literature. Throughout the school year, various performance opportunities will be made available and/or are required.

(SHHS Additional Information)

Symphonic Band is the most advanced concert ensemble at Sterling Heights High School. Primarily 11th and 12th grade band students are in this class with the occasional 10th grade band student. Because the level of literature in this class and the very fast pacing, students must audition to be accepted into this class.

Attendance at all performances is required.**

COURSE OFFERINGS

JAZZ BAND (VPA)

COURSE ID: HS5121/HS5122

(WCS High School Course Description Guide)

This unique instrumental music ensemble performs a wide variety of jazz, rock, blues, and other types of music utilizing the jazz/rock band instrumentation. Instrumentation includes trumpet, trombone, saxophone, drums, piano, guitar, and bass.

(SHHS Additional Information)

Jazz Band is primarily 11th and 12th grade band students wishing to learn about jazz music. Occasionally we have a few 10th grade band students as well. Students who elect Jazz Band in their schedule are also in a concert ensemble. In Jazz Band we learn how to perform in various jazz styles, including swing, blues, bebop, funk, rock, and more. We also learn basic jazz theory as well as the history of jazz, particularly how it relates to the history of the United States. Students must audition to be accepted into this ensemble.

**All classes require membership by audition only.
Attendance at all performances is required.**

MARCHING BAND (co-curricular)

The Marching Band is made up of 9th - 12th grade band students from our 3 concert ensembles. Colorguard members do not need to be in a band class. Marching Band students are required to attend two weeks of band camp as well as once a week evening rehearsals during the fall. Also required to be at all performances.

Although Marching Band is not a class, students who successfully complete two seasons of marching band are able to waive the ½ credit Physical Education requirement! Full participation at every performance and rehearsal is required for eligibility.

Did you know? In addition to in-school band meeting the Visual, Performing, & Applied Arts (VPA) graduation requirement, further band classes may be used towards other graduation requirements.

Students that attend Warren Consolidated Schools, and specifically Sterling Heights High School, are fortunate to have many different options and learning pathways to explore their interests and prepare for their lives beyond high school.

**Band can be part of the curriculum all throughout
Middle and High School for all students.**

We believe strongly in giving students that wish to participate in Instrumental Music the opportunity to do so while also working collaboratively to meet every student's other academic interests and needs.

Scheduling Considerations for Band Students

- Band will fulfil any of the 4.5 credits of required electives.
- One full year of band will fulfill the Visual, Performing, & Applied Arts (VPA) requirement.
- Completing two seasons of marching band will fulfill the Physical Education requirement.
- Students may also test out of taking a language. (See next page)
- A second full year of band could fulfil a part of the World Language requirement; however this is not always advisable.

Important note: Some, but not all, universities require at least two years of the same world language for admission. It is advisable to explore the requirements of any college or university you plan on applying to in advance of completing your high school schedules.
